

INFORMATION PACKAGE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENT APPLICATIONS

What are the Requirements for Application?

- 1) Students coming from abroad must meet the following conditions in order to apply to the faculties / vocational schools and institutes of Çağ University:
 - a) Having graduated from a high school or equivalent school whose equivalence is accepted by the Republic of Turkey, Ministry of National Education,
 - b) Having received the valid score from one of the international exam or high school graduation grading systems in the Table of Criteria for Accepting Students from Abroad in APPENDIX-1, the "Exam" result is valid.)
 - c) The equivalence certificate is to be obtained from the Higher Education Institution (YÖK) of the candidates who will apply for a Master's Degree from countries that are not included in the Bologna process.
- 2) Applications of the following candidates are accepted:
 - a. Those who are Foreign nationals.
 - b. Those who are Turkish citizens by birth but lose their Turkish citizenship by obtaining permission from the Ministry of Internal Affairs to renounce their Turkish citizenship, and those who certify that they have a blue card, which is given upon request to those who lost their Turkish citizenship,
 - c. Those who acquired Turkish citizenship after being a foreign national/dual national in this situation,
 - d. Among the Turkish students who continued their secondary education abroad before February 1, 2013, those who completed the last three years of their secondary education (high school) in a foreign country excluding the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (including those who completed their entire secondary education (high school) in a Turkish school established by the Ministry of National Education in a foreign country other than the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus),
 - e) Those who are Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus nationals, residing in the TRNC and have completed secondary education (high school) in the TRNC and have GCEAL exam results, and those who have or will have GCE AL exam results by enrolling in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005-2010,
- 3) Applications of the following candidates are not accepted:

- a) Those who are Turkish nationals and have completed all of their secondary education (high school) in Turkey or the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC)
- b) TRNC nationals (except those who have completed their secondary education in TRNC high schools and have a GCE AL result),
- c) Dual nationals, whose first nationality is Republic of Turkey by birth as defined in 6-b/2.
- d) Dual citizens whose nationality is TRNC (except those who have completed their secondary education in TRNC high schools and have a GCE AL result),
- e) Those who are Turkish citizens or dual nationals whose first nationality is Turkish by birth as defined in article 6-2/b, who studied at schools within the embassies in Turkey and foreign high schools in Turkey,

Those who renounced their Turkish citizenship/Blue Card holders, TRNC citizens, and foreign nationals (embassy schools, international private education institutions in the MOBIS System, and foreigners brought to our country within the framework of the project carried out by the Ministry of National Education) who enroll in secondary education institutions in Turkey as of the 2022-2023 academic year. citizens) will be able to register for higher education institutions only with the Higher Education Institutions Exam (YKS).

What are the Documents Required for Application?

- a) Notary-certified or consular-approved English or Turkish translation of the high school diploma (the original of the diploma and the document showing its equivalence with Turkish diplomas will be requested during registration),
- b) Transcript of Records (Transcript, a document showing the courses taken in high school and the grades obtained from these courses, approved by the relevant school administration, translated into English or Turkish, approved by a notary public or consulate),
- d) An English language proficiency exam result document, if any, with international validity and obtained within the last two years,
- e) Document showing Turkish language proficiency, if any,
- f) A copy of the passport page showing the identity information (if it is not Turkish or English, a copy of the passport translated into one of these languages and approved by the notary public or consulate), (Original passport will be shown during registration.)
- g) A certified copy of the exam result document of one of the exams listed below, if any;

- 1) When the official exam result document regarding the high school graduation exams (Abitur, International Baccalaureate, GCE, Tawjihi, etc.) approved by the Council of Higher Education or the exams in the status of university entrance exams (SAT, YÖS, etc.) taken within the last two years is approved by Çag University can be taken into consideration when deemed appropriate.
- 2) Apart from the relevant exams stated at the end of the directive, the high school diploma grade or university entrance exam document in the country of origin of the student candidate can also be taken into consideration by Çag University when deemed appropriate.
- 3) There is no limitation on the validity periods of the exams (Abitur, International Baccalaureate, GCE, Tawjihi, etc.) that are in the status of high school graduation exams. However, the results of the university entrance exam (SAT I and ACT) and YÖS are valid for two years.
- 4) The applications of international student candidates who apply to ÖSYS (Student Selection and Placement Exam) and have a result document can be evaluated by Çag University.

How are Applications Evaluated?

- 1) An "Evaluation and Admission Committee " is established by the Rectorate, consisting of representatives of the Institute, Faculty, and Vocational School, in order to make the final evaluation on the admission of students from abroad who apply to faculties and vocational schools affiliated to Çag University.
- 2) The Evaluation and Admission Committee evaluates student applications within the framework of Article 6 and makes a decision.
- 3) Evaluations are made within the framework of the quotas, taking into account the exam scores of the candidates, the overall grade point averages in the transcripts, references, and letters of intent, and the main and substitute candidates whose admission is deemed appropriate are determined. As a result of the evaluation, the other preferences of the candidate who is placed in one of his preferences as a permanent or substitute are not taken into consideration.
- 4) The proposal prepared by the Evaluation and Admission Committee becomes final with the approval of the University Administrative Board.
- 5) Application results are announced on the university's website. Applicants are not notified individually.

How to Register the Accepted Applications?

- 1) The final registration of the students admitted to the university is made by the Department of Students' Affairs of Çag University within the framework of the Regulations for Associate and Undergraduate Education and Examinations of Çag University and the Regulation for Graduate Education and Examination.

- 2) During registration, students must submit the originals of the following documents to the Department of Students' Affairs:
- a) True copy of the high school diploma, and English or Turkish sample from the Republic of Turkey representative offices located in their own countries.
 - b) The document obtained from the Republic of Turkey, Ministry of National Education, or document obtained from the representative office, shows that the high school diploma obtained from foreign countries is equivalent to the diplomas obtained from Turkish high schools.
 - c) The true copies of the Examination Result Document and the T.R. English or Turkish copy approved by the representative office,
 - d) Bank receipt showing that tuition fees have been paid,
 - e) Original and copies of official ID or passport,
 - f) Student visa to be obtained from the representative office of the Republic of Turkey, (Candidates in Turkey get their Student Visa from the Provincial Immigration Administration.)
 - g) 6 passport-size photographs,
 - h) Student Residence Permit, which is mandatory for international students to obtain from the Provincial Directorate of Migration Management after registration.

During the application, placement, and registration process, the registration procedures of students who submit falsified, fake, incomplete, or incorrect documents are canceled even if their final registration has been made.

Registration of the students who do not submit the documents required for registration (diploma, equivalence certificate, Turkish and foreign language proficiency documents, etc.) to the Registrar's Office on the committed date will be canceled through the decision of the relevant Vocational School/Faculty Administrative Board.

What is the Tuition Fee of Çağ University?

At Çağ University, tuition fees are charged. Fees are determined by the Board of Trustees each year and announced on the university's website.

How are Educational Activities Conducted at Çağ University?

- 1) The education of foreign students at the university is carried out within the framework of Çağ University Associate Degree and Undergraduate Education and Examination Regulations and Postgraduate Education and Examination Regulations.
- 2) Candidates who cannot document their English Proficiency at B1 Level take the English Proficiency Exam.
 - a) An English proficiency exam is held within the framework of “Çağ University Foreign Language Education and Foreign Languages Preparatory Education Regulation” and the relevant provisions of this regulation are applied to the student according to the exam result. The exams are determined by the University Senate and those who pass the exam by getting the base score are exempted from the proficiency exam.
- 3) Regarding Turkish proficiency;
 - i) From the Turkish test conducted by a language training center approved by the Republic of Turkey, Ministry of National Education and Higher Education Institutions;
 - (i) Those with A-level scores start their education immediately,
 - (ii) Those who get B-level scores are obliged to start their education immediately, but also to improve their Turkish,
 - (iii) Those who have a C level score are obliged to learn Turkish until the end of one (1) year, when they are considered to be on leave, and they start their education after certifying that they have learned Turkish.
 - (iv) Except for the units where the language of instruction is entirely in a foreign language, those who are registered to the units teaching in a foreign language, whose Turkish will be sufficient in a short time (B level) or those whose Turkish is insufficient (C level) start their education; however, they are obliged to improve and prove their Turkish by taking Turkish courses until they reach a sufficient level.
 - j) Those who get a Turkish Language Proficiency Certificate from a language training center approved by the Republic of Turkey, Ministry of National Education and approved by the University Senate, start their education immediately, and those who cannot get it are obliged to learn Turkish until the end of one (1) year, when they will be deemed to be on leave, and start their education after certifying that they have learned Turkish.
